DEVELOPMENT IN RAIL PROXIMITY ZONES



CURRENT / INTERIM APPROACH

- Applies to residential, commercial > 3 storeys and all frame construction
- Applies to portions of building(s) within the 30 m Rail Proximity Zone

 Addiction treatment Assisted living Custodial care Temporary/emergency shelter Private school School authority Child care service 	 Hospital Jail Residential care



WORK PROGRAM

- Balance safety with recognition of Municipal Development Plan and owner rights under Land Use Bylaw.
- 2. Baseline Risk Assessment
 - Q2 2017 completion.
 - Industry representatives on review panel.
 - Measure <u>real</u> risks, no recommendation for mitigation.
- 3. Mitigation (if any) to recognize risk and be site specific



4. New policy to replace Current/Interim Approach – Q2 2018


THE GREEN LINE LRT



DOWNTOWN ALIGNMENT

- Underground alignment approved <u>in principal</u>.
- Continue lobbying efforts until final approval.

BELTLINE ALIGNMENT

- Two remaining options both along 12th Ave.
- Consensus: underground alignment preferred.
- Some councilors concerned: too much \$ spent in City Centre.
- Beltline alignment approval: March 2017 (delay to June?).

CASH IN LIEU PARKING



CURRENT STATUS

- June 2016 Council approved Integrated Downtown-TOD Parking Strategy including:
 - √ 1 stall per 140 sm (~1,500 sf) of GBA limit (no change).
 - ✓ End cash-in-lieu program all parking now on-site.
 - ✓ Relaxations of up to 50% below requirements by payment of new levy (amount TBD).

WORK PLAN

- New policy (to be developed by March 2017), to include:
 - ✓ Review of short-stay parking.
 - ✓ Formalize elimination of mandatory cash-in-lieu; replace with voluntary cash-in-lieu.
 - ✓ Alignment of Beltline, East Village and Chinatown policies with Downtown.
